

Dear Parents,

Listed below are the supplies your child will require for **Grade 1 with Mrs. Jones 2025/2026** school year (some supplies may need replenishing later in the year). *Books will be labelled in class - please just write names INSIDE them.* Please leave the crayons, markers, etc. in their original boxes *after labelling each piece*. We will organize pencil boxes together.

- 1/2 Interlined, 1/2 Plain
- □ 2 scribblers, ½ interlined, ½ plain with 72 pages
  - 20 pencils (<u>sharpened</u>). \* No plastic coated or sparkly pencils please - they break the sharpener
- □ 3 white erasers
- □ 1 dry erase marker, any colour
- □ 1 box of 24 crayons
- □ 1 pkg of at least 12 pencil crayons (**sharpened**)
- □ 1 pkg of at least 8 regular **thick tip** markers
- 9 duotangs (1 each red, green, yellow, orange, purple, blue and black, 2 more of your choice, may be patterned)) \*The folder colours are used for different subjects, so please stick to these colours
- 1 yellow pocket folder
- **5** large glue sticks OR 10 small glue sticks
- 1 bottle white glue
- scissors
- 1 pencil box or large pencil case
- □ 1-30 cm primary metric ruler
- 1 headphone set labelled with name in its own Ziploc bag with name on it over the head work best, please no ear buds. Corded ones are easiest for kids.
- 1 old button up or t-shirt that is too large (adult works) for paint smock, labelled with name, in a Ziploc bag to keep in locker
- running shoes (with non-marking soles) for indoor use and gym labelled with name <u>\*If your child DOES NOT KNOW HOW TO TIE shoes, please DO NOT send lace ups</u>
- **2** empty **Large** Ziploc bags, **name on them**
- 20 plastic spoons to keep in locker (not enough for daily use, only for back up when they are forgotten)
- □ 1 NON-SPILL, plastic or metal water bottle- push button
- 1 lunch bag
- 1 set of extra clothes, labelled, in a bag that has their name on it to be kept in locker

\*Please make sure that <u>EACH INDIVIDUAL CRAYON, MARKER OR PENCIL IS LABELLED</u> with your child's name using a permanent marker or label. *This will save you money and your child frustration in the long run*.
